To reach the staff ring doorbell, tell staff that you are from Alcoholics Anonymous and you are there to speak at Hannick Hall. Also, be sure to ask for the folder with readings, make sure you return ALL readings with the folder to staff before leaving!

#### When:

This commitment is every Wednesday night at 6:15pm with different assigned groups each month.

## **Guidelines and expectations for speaking:**

Two speakers each week

One speaker must have at least one year of sobriety.

Each speaker gives a 15-20 minute lead, then opens the meeting up for discussion. Patients at the facility may have questions. Please as a speaker answer the questions they ask unless it doesn't pertain to recovery.

## **Speaking points:**

Avoid a drunk a log.

Carry the message by sharing your experience, strength and hope.

Talk about your experience with the 12 steps of Alcoholics Anonymous.

Talk about how life is better in sobriety and how the promises have worked in your life.

The goal is to give hope and to describe how recovery has benefited your life!
